Closure Attributes



STACKING RING

A Stacking Ring is the raised portion on the top edge of a closure. Its purpose is to allow packaging to be stacked with the container above.

FINE RIBBED

Closures with thin, raised lines around the exterior sides are considered Fine Ribbed. These "ribs" create friction in the hand to make opening the closure easier.

SMOOTH ←


Smooth closures are great for adding labels or completing a sleek look.

METAL-SHELLED •

A plastic closure wrapped with metal, Metal-Shelled closures provide an added sense of luxury.

BOLD RIBBED •

Similar to Fine Ribbed, Bold Ribbed closures have thicker raised "ribs" which aids in opening larger closures.



SMOOTH VS. MATTE/STIPPLE TOP

While Smooth-Topped closures are appropriate for adding labels, Matte or Stipple-Topped Closures are not. However, unlike Smooth-Topped Closures, having a Stipple-Top generates friction with the container above when stacked, reducing the chance of falling off the shelf.
